

RESOLUTION NO 2025-

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LAKE ELSINORE, CALIFORNIA ADOPTING A LIST OF PROJECTS FOR FISCAL YEAR 2025- 2026 FUNDED BY SB 1: THE ROAD REPAIR AND ACCOUNTABILITY ACT OF 2017

Whereas, Senate Bill 1 (SB 1), the Road Repair and Accountability Act of 2017 (Chapter 5, Statutes of 2017) was passed by the Legislature and Signed into law by the Governor in April 2017 in order to address the significant multi-modal transportation funding shortfalls statewide; and

Whereas, SB 1 includes accountability and transparency provisions that will ensure the residents of our City of Lake Elsinore are aware of the projects proposed for funding in our community and which projects have been completed each fiscal year; and

Whereas, the City of Lake Elsinore must adopt a list of all projects proposed to receive funding from the Road Maintenance and Rehabilitation Account (RMRA), created by SB 1 by resolution, which must include a description and the location of each proposed project, a proposed schedule for the project's completion, and the estimated useful life of the improvement; and

Whereas, the City of Lake Elsinore, will receive and estimated \$1,935,163 in RMRA funding in Fiscal Year 2025-2026 from SB 1; and

Whereas, this is the ninth year in which the City of Lake Elsinore is receiving SB 1 funding and will enable the City of Lake Elsinore to continue essential road maintenance and rehabilitation projects, safety improvements, repairing and replacing aging bridges, and increasing access and mobility options for the traveling public that would not have otherwise been possible without SB 1; and

Whereas, the City of Lake Elsinore has undergone a robust public process to ensure public input into our community's transportation priorities/the project list; and

Whereas, the City of Lake Elsinore used a Pavement Management System to develop the SB 1 project list to ensure revenues are being used on the most high-priority and cost-effective projects that also meet the communities priorities for transportation investment; and

Whereas, the funding from SB 1 will help the City of Lake Elsinore maintain and rehabilitate 6 streets/roads, and add active transportation infrastructure throughout the City of Lake Elsinore this year and hundreds of similar projects into the future; and

Whereas, the 2023 California Statewide Local Streets and Roads Needs Assessment found that the City's streets and roads are in "at-risk" condition and this revenue will help us increase the overall quality of our road system and over the next decade will bring our streets and roads into a "good" condition; and

Whereas, the SB 1 project list and overall investment in our local streets and roads infrastructure with a focus on basic maintenance and safety, investing in complete streets infrastructure, and using cutting-edge technology, materials and practices, will have significant positive co-benefits statewide.

NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LAKE ELSINORE DOES HEREBY RESOLVE, DETERMINE AND ORDER AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The foregoing recitals are true and correct.

Section 2. The Fiscal Year 2025-26 list of projects planned to be funded with Road Maintenance and Rehabilitation Account revenues include:

The Lakeshore Drive and Mission Trail Pavement Rehabilitation Project will consist of, 2 inch of grind and overlay and 3 inch grind and overlay, depending on the existing condition of pavement. The project is located in the east area of the City of Lake Elsinore, in Riverside County, California. The useful life of the project is expected to be around 10 to 12 years with design to start in July 2025 and be completed in September 2025 and construction to start in February 2026 and be completed in May 2026.
