WHEREAS, the City of Lake Elsinore Emergency Services, through programs such as its RivCoReady campaign, Federal Emergency Management Agency's (FEMA) Ready Campaign, and other federal, state, local, tribal, territorial, private, and volunteer agencies are working to increase public activities in preparing for emergencies and to educate individuals on how to take action;
