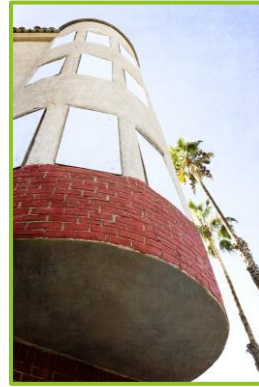

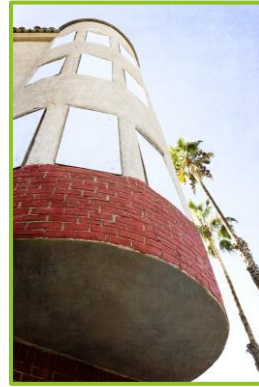

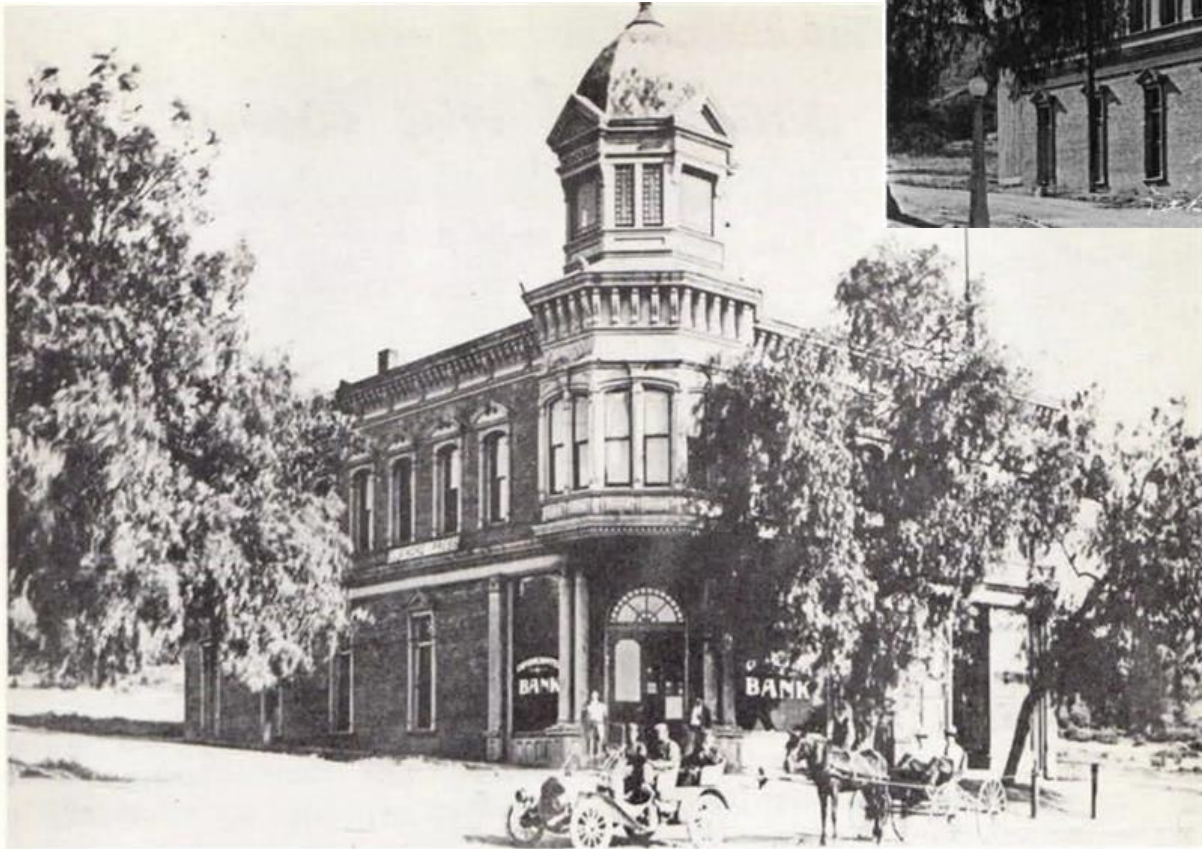

AMBASSADOR HISTORY

In 1887, the Exchange Bank of Lake Elsinore was founded with Franklin H. Heald as president. It is located on the corner of Prospect and Main Streets, and most of the original building still stands. This 1927 photograph (right) depicts how the bank looked. The Exchange Bank of Elsinore and the Bank of Elsinore consolidated in 1890 and assumed the name Consolidated Bank of Elsinore. In 1916, the Consolidated Bank building became the new Ambassador Hotel. (*Images of America—Lake Elsinore*, by Edythe J. Greene, Elizabeth Helper, and Mary Louise Rowden, pg. 34)

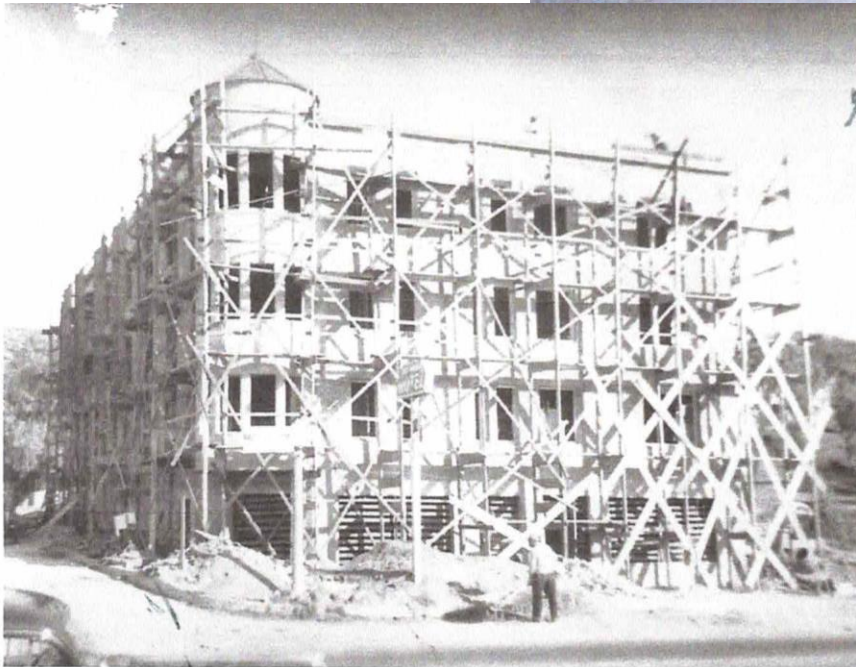


The above picture was taken in 1927. The picture to the left appears to have been taken a few years later judging from the growth of the trees in front of the building. Notice the car, horse-and-buggy, and person standing out front... all three offer a helpful reference point for the height of the front doors as well as the overall building height.

The picture to the below was taken in March of 1947 during a remodel that completely overhauled not only the exterior of the Ambassador Hotel but also inserted two additional floors into the existing structure taking the building from having two twenty-foot floors to four ten-foot floors.

In 1992, due to a series of code enforcement issues, the Ambassador Hotel was ordered closed and has since fallen into disrepair.

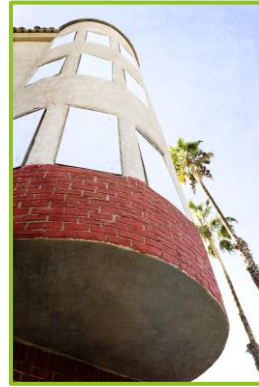


The **AMBASSADOR** *Project*

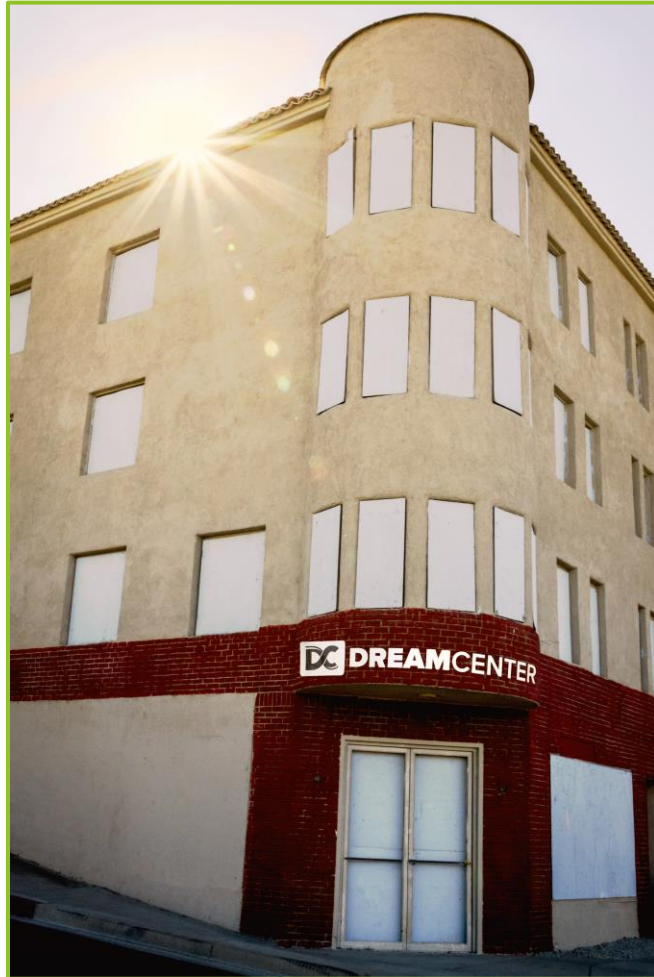

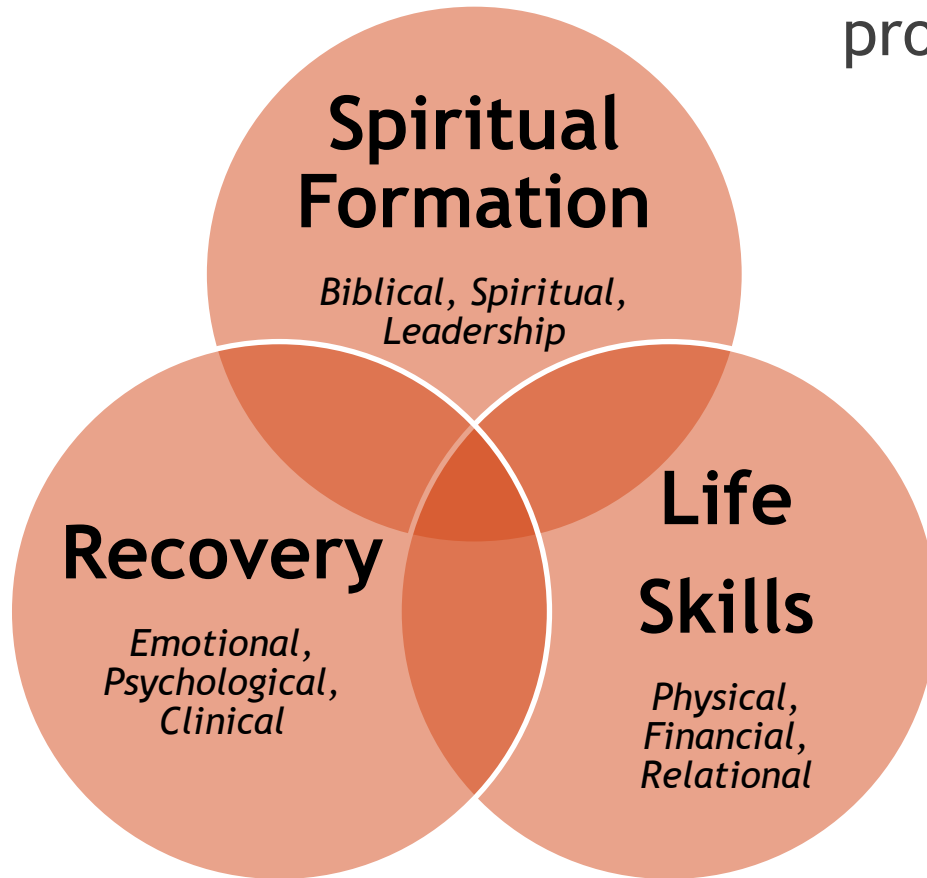
PROGRAM OVERVIEW
