

SECOND AMENDMENT TO THE AGREEMENT FOR LAW ENFORCEMENT
SERVICES BETWEEN THE CITY OF LAKE ELSINORE
AND THE COUNTY OF RIVERSIDE

IT IS MUTUALLY AGREED that the Agreement for Law Enforcement Services between the County of Riverside, a political subdivision of the State of California, on behalf of the Riverside County Sheriff's Department, and the City of Lake Elsinore, a General Law City, approved by the Board of Supervisors on August 4, 2020 in Minute Order 3.47 for services effective July 1, 2020 through June 30, 2025, as amended in that certain First Amendment on July 20, 2021 (Minute Order 3.31) (collectively, the "Agreement") is hereby amended in the following respects, and all other terms and conditions of the Agreement remain in full force and effect:
