Subject: Eighth Amendment to License Agreement with California Family Life Center

for the Planet Youth Program

# Recommendation

Approve and authorize the City Manager to execute the Eighth Amendment with California Life Center for Planet Youth in such final form as approved by the City Attorney.

### **Background**

Planet Youth is an organization that prepares "At-Risk" youth to enter into the workforce with the necessary skills to be successful. Beginning with the original License Agreement in 2008, the City and California Family Life Center (CFLC) began partnering to offer the facility at 400 W. Graham for the services. The first Amendment was approved by City Council and went through June 30, 2012. To date, there have been seven subsequent Amendments.

#### **Discussion**

In discussions with the California Family Life Center, the organization preferred to continue a three-year License Agreement – nonexclusive license to access the facility for three years, commencing on July 1, 2023 through June 30, 2028, with the ability to extend for the year-to-year for two additional years. CFLC will continue to pay the monthly license fee of \$500.

### Fiscal Impact

No additional impact is anticipated.
