Subject: **Cooperative Funding Agreement Between County of Riverside and the City of Lake Elsinore for Audelo St., Machado St., Meadowlake Ln., Natalie Dr., Patrick Ct. Slurry Seal Improvements**

Recommendation

Approve the Cooperative Funding Agreement with County of Riverside in substantially the form attached and in such final form as approved by the City Attorney for the Audelo St., Machado St., Meadowlake Ln., Natalie Dr., Patrick Ct. Slurry Seal Improvements in the not to exceed amount of \$83,536.44.

Background

This agreement will establish the funding and construction of the two (2) agencies involved in the Slurry Seal and Curb Ramp Accessibility Project delivery.

The total cost of the Slurry Seal Improvements requested by the City of Lake Elsinore is shown on Exhibit "B" of the Agreement. The City contribution of the requested Street Improvements of the project shall not exceed Eighty-Three Thousand Five Hundred Thirty-Six Dollars and Forty-four Cents (\$83,536.44)

The Implementing Agency is the party responsible for managing the scope, cost, schedule, and quality of the work activities and products of a project component. County of Riverside is the Plans, Specifications, and Estimate (PS&E) Implementing Agency.

Discussion

The County currently has a Roadway Improvement Project along the the east and west sides of Grand Avenue from Machado Street to Audelo Street, which includes work outside of the County's jurisdiction. County and City have mutually agreed that the following wide local streets segments are in need of roadway improvements: segment 1 is Audelo St. from 877' E of Grand Ave to Grand Ave (approximately 877 linear feet by 20 feet wide), segment 2 is Audelo St. from

877' E of Grand Ave to Rocking Horse Ct. (approximately 650 linear feet by 33 feet wide), segment 3 is Machado St. from 200' N of Alvarado St. to 700' N of Grand Ave. (approximately 2,230 linear feet by 38 feet wide), segment 4 is Machado St. from 700' N of Grand Ave. to Grand Ave. (approximately 700 linear feet by 30 feet wide), segment 5 is Meadowlake Ln. from Natalie Dr. to 1250' SW of Natalie Dr. (approximately 1,250 linear feet by 36 feet wide), segment 6 is Natalie Dr. from Machado St. to Meadowlake Ln. (approximately 330 linear feet by 36 feet wide), segment 7 is Patrick Ct. from Grand Ave. to 286' W of Grand Ave. (approximately 286 linear feet by 28 feet wide)

In addition to slurry seal, project also includes traffic control, rout and seal random cracks, replacement of any pavement markings, including cross walks, striping and raised pavement markers.

City and County have determined that it is more economical to have the County complete the Street Improvement Project under its contract for the Project;

Fiscal Impact

The City will reimburse County of Riverside the City's contribution of the requested Street Improvements of the project the amount of Seventy-Six Thousand Five Hundred Seventeen Dollars (\$83,536.44). Funds are allocated within the adopted CIP Budget.
