### **Recommendation**

Approve Road Closures for the Main Street Eats event to be held on Saturday, July 29, 2023.

### **Background**

The Community Services Department was excited to collaborate with local group, Made Local to bring the Main Street Eats event series to Historic Main Street during the month of May. We are bringing this event back for July 29, 2023. This event will feature a large variety of food booths, local vendors, photo opportunities, and live entertainment. We have scheduled a diverse lineup of local artists to showcase the talent in and around our community. We are expecting this event to attract a large number of visitors to our downtown area. In addition, the event will also support local businesses, promote the downtown area, and provide a fun and family-friendly experience for visitors.

### **Discussion**

Main Street Eats is planned to take place on July 29 on Main Street in Downtown Lake Elsinore from 5:00 to 9:00 p.m. The Community Services Department, Public Works Department, and Sheriff's Department will coordinate resources to ensure public safety. As a result, staff is recommending street closures on Main Street between Heald and Limited as detailed in Attachment 1. It is recommended that these street closures remain in place from 12:00 p.m. to 10:30 p.m. The street closures will be enforced by Law Enforcement personnel.
